WHO MAY ENROLL

Classes are open to adults (18 years of age and older) who are not currently attending another high school. Married persons under age of 18 and/or those who have custody of a child may also attend.

HOW TO REGISTER

Before registering, you will need to have the following items:

- 1. A picture I.D.
- 2. Official transcripts from all the schools you have attended. Official transcripts are transcripts that have been sealed in an envelope by your previous school(s). Do NOT open your official transcripts.

To receive an Adult School Diploma, a student must complete the following requirements:
